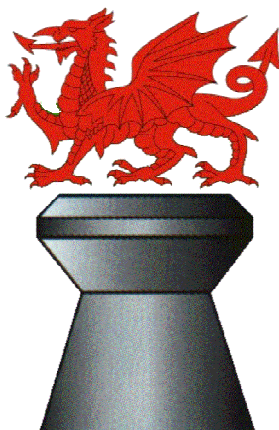

## Course of fire

60 shot competitions to be completed in 1 hour 45 minutes and 40 shot competitions to be completed in 1 hour 15 minutes, all to be shot generally in accordance with the current ISSF Rules. All classes (rifle and pistol) will shoot one shot per card.

Disabled competitors are welcome and will be eligible to win class and aggregate competitions, but will not be entitled to the title of Open Championship Winner. There will not be any Olympic Finals for disabled competitors.

Entered competitions may be shot in any order, by your squadding choice, e.g. Competition 2 may be shot before Competition 1.

**N.B.** Once you have received your Squadding notice you will have 24 hours to request a change in the squadding (i.e. change the order in which you wish to shoot the competitions), after this no changes to your squadding will be allowed, unless there are extenuating circumstances.

## Olympic Finals

The top eight Senior rifle, the top eight Junior rifle, the top eight Senior pistol and the top eight Junior pistol competitors will qualify for Olympic Finals on paper targets.

The Finals have the following provisional start times on Sunday:-

Senior Pistol Final	1.15pm	Junior Pistol Final	2pm
Senior Rifle Final	2.45pm	Junior Rifle Final	3.30pm

The top eight for each Final will be decided by the leading 8 scores (in any Class) in Competition 1 shot up to and including Squad F (Sunday 9am). In the event of tied scores, inner 10s will be used to decide the Finals places.

Please indicate “Yes” or “No” on the entry form as to whether you are available for the Olympic Final. If you have indicated “Yes” on the entry form and, for some reason, are no longer available please let Stats know so that the lists can be altered.

## **Competition Location**

All competition will take place in the Sports Hall at Ellesmere College, Ellesmere, Shropshire, SY12 9AB. The College's web site is <http://www.ellesmere.com>

## **Accommodation**

Accommodation (Bed & Full English Breakfast), evening meals and packed lunches can be booked on the Accommodation Booking Form.

Accommodation and meals must be booked with the Association, not with the College.

The 21<sup>st</sup> February 2011 ISSF "Dress Code V3" interpretation (of the existing rules) will not be applied). Denim jeans may be worn.

## **Teams**

Competition 7 is for Teams of 3 in rifle and pistol. The competition is shot concurrently with Competition 1 with any three people forming a team (people do not have to come from the same Club).

Cost is £5 per team - one person pays and the Team Entry form is to be completed before any of the team has shot.

There is a Team Entry form on the reverse side of the individual entry form for the printed entry form or as the second page in the PDF entry form.

Equipment Control and Stats will have extra copies of the Team Entry forms.

## **Shot diagrams**

Shot diagrams may be collected from Equipment Control approximately 20 minutes after you have finished shooting. Shot targets may be collected after the Protest Time.

**Entries – There are 30 firing points per Squad – send in your entry early in order to make sure you get your first choice Squad.**
