Course of fire (all competitions will be shot on electronic targets)

The format for the meeting is separate competitions (60 shots in 1 hour 15 minutes) on each of the three days (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) with Olympic Finals on each day in a separate Finals Hall no Olympic Finals for Disabled).

Decimal scoring will be used in the rifle competitions.

Each competitor will need to declare a competition 'level', with Level A being experienced in competition and Level B as inexperienced, or beginner, level.

Competitors who declare as Level A will be expected to comply with the current ISSF Rules.

Although both rifle and pistol competitors have been asked to declare a 'level', the level only really applies to rifle competitors.

The intention is for rifle competitors, who are using 'club' clothing or second-hand clothing that may not fully comply with ISSF rules, to be allowed some leeway at equipment control for rifle clothing.

Both Level A and B competitors will be expected to comply with all other ISSF rules.

There will be one combined prize list for each competition on each day.

There are no separate Classes.

The Finalists will be drawn from either level.

Levels (this does not mean 'Classes')

Rifle – average ex 600 (ex 654 in decimal*)

	<i>Integer</i>	<i>Decimal</i>
Level A	550 and above	575 and above
Level B	549.9 and below	574.9 and below

Pistol – average ex 600

Level A	519 and above
Level B	518.9 and below

*** Decimal scoring will be used in the rifle competitions**

Four competitions are to be held each day, with separate Olympic Finals for Seniors and Juniors on Friday, Saturday and Sunday (Disabled competitors shoot at the same time).

One entry fee of £80.00 will cover entry for all three days, Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

N.B. No discount if you shoot only one or two days.

There will not be Olympic Finals for disabled competitors (one combined prize list for senior and junior rifle each day and one combined senior and junior prize list for pistol each day).

A team competition (£6.00) will be held concurrently with the competitions on Saturday with any three people forming a team (people do not have to come from the same Club) – one person pays and the team entry form must be handed in to the Registration Desk before any of the team has shot.

There is a team entry form on the reverse side of the individual entry form for the printed entry form or as the second page in the PDF entry form (extra copies will be available at the Registration Desk).

The Welsh Closed Championships will be shot concurrently with the competitions on Sunday.

Special notice of withdrawal from match

In the event that a competitor's fired shots hit the electronic scoring target protection plate more than 3 times in a competition, the competitor will be deemed unsafe for that event and will have to withdraw. The score that they have fired for record will be entered into the result sheets.

If you don't think you can keep all the shots on the target, then maybe this isn't the competition for you. Ideally, you should have competed in other domestic competitions before this meeting.

Olympic Finals

Please indicate "Yes" or "No" on the entry form as to whether you will be available for the Olympic Finals. If you have indicated "Yes" on the entry form and, for some reason, are no longer available, please let the Registration Desk know at the earliest opportunity so that the lists can be altered.

On-line results

It is planned that the scores will be available via on-line results services.

Random equipment control check

A number of competitors in each competition, on each day, will be randomly selected to go through equipment control after they have finished shooting in that competition.

Clothing regulations

Clothing rules will be as per 6.7.5 of the ISSF Rules Edition 2017 Second Print Version 1.1 01/2018.

Cylinder dates

Dates of cylinders will be checked and suitable advice will be given if the cylinder is over 10 years old, but competitors will be allowed to compete at their own discretion.

Shot diagram printouts

Shot diagram printouts may be collected from the Registration Desk approximately 20 minutes after the end of each competition.

Mobile telephones

All mobile telephones should be turned OFF before entering the Main Hall. Notices to this effect will be posted on the entrance doors to the Main Hall and within the Main Hall.

Receipts for entry fees

If you require a receipt for your entry fees, please tick the box on the entry form.

Compressed air

Compressed air will be available during the meeting, however, availability cannot be guaranteed. Please bring your own adapter that fits your rifle or pistol. CO₂ will not be available.

Accommodation

Anyone requiring information on hotels and B&Bs please request an accommodation list with your entry.

Saturday evening dinner

A Dinner will be held in the Sophia Suite on Saturday evening. Please indicate the number of tickets required on the entry form.
